



S 8 • RECONSTRUCTION OF A SKULL OF HOMO RUDOLFENSIS

Natural size, in SOMSO-PLAST[®]. Expert guidance for the reconstruction provided by the Department for Prehistoric Anthropology and Human Ecology of the University of Göttingen. Site and date of find: The reconstruction combined with the skull find of Koobi Fora, eastern Turkana region, Kenya, 1972, and the mandible find of Uraha, Malawi, 1991, age: approximately 2.5-1.9 million years, upper Pliocene.

Separates into 2 parts. Weight: 750 g
